

Abstract

The Disturbances of the Spectrum of Autism (ASP) are a Global Perturbations of Development that affect three great areas: The Communication, the Social Interaction and the Symbolic Game and Repertory of Interests. Given to the particularities of this pathology many times the intervention work extremely becomes difficult to carry through. Therefore, each time it becomes more pertinent to bet in new strategies that can be used so that these children and young can develop in the direction of its full development and its inclusion in the schools and the society. These will always have to be more playful and creative and having as main objective the intervention on the great limitations provoked by the pathology. Thus, this work is based on the accomplishment of an intervention program that has, as main objective, the increase of some dimensions of the Communication Non - Verbal (Corporal Expression, Face Expression, Kinesis and Proxemics) in a group of 11 young children/young through Dance and the Expressive Movement.

The results of our work demonstrated that positive alterations have been verified, statistical pertinent, in the generality of the evaluated items. In this sense, the hypotheses proposals have been confirmed and the program allowed increasing the levels of Communication - Non - Verbal in the group of young children/ young of our study.
